The **Libertaria Reservation** /lɪbərtɛriə rɛzərvɛʃən/ is a section in the southwestern United States primarily located in the state of Arizona. Libertaria derives it's name from Libertarian, a political ideology that saw a surge in popularity at the turn of the 21st century. The reservation was established in 2020 after a rise in US anti-libertarian sentiment which followed the assassination of President Barack Obama.

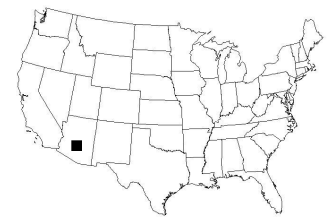

History

At the turn of the 21st century the [libertarian party](#) was at the peak of it's power and popularity. Over ten percent of the US voting population considered itself libertarian. Libertarians believed in limited government intervention with everyday life. They grew increasingly dogmatic during [The Great Recession](#). Their growing dissatisfaction with the US government culminated in the assassination of President [Barak Obama](#), which has been largely attributed to [Michelle Bachman](#) aide: [Ted Anders](#), a fact that has been vehemently contested and embraced by the libertarian party. The assassination was followed by strong US anti-libertarian
